

## **Humidity Control System**

The weather in Hawaii is not kind to pianos. The constant high humidity and salt air causes strings to rust and action parts to swell and stick.

For upright pianos, there are two methods of keeping the humidity inside the piano under control. A Damp-chaser unit removes moisture from the inside of the piano. A Bull Frog Rust Blocker Shield prevents moisture from attaching to the strings, which prevents rust.

For grand pianos, the best way to keep moisture out of the piano is to place a naugahide string cover over the strings, a Rust Blocker Shield to keep rust off the strings, and a damp-chaser unit inside the piano to keep the moisture out of the piano action.
